


Bringing Comfort

"'Comfort, comfort my people,' says your God. 'Speak tenderly to Jerusalem..." This command is relevant to us today. Israel bears fresh wounds—scarred by war, loss, and the strain of living under constant threat.

Sitting with survivors of the October 7 attacks, hearing their harrowing stories of miraculous escapes and of the devastation of shattered homes, their eyes held both deep sorrow and a stubborn spark of life. In each story, I witnessed endurance and the refusal to let hatred define them.

Isaiah's call to comfort begins with being present—listening without hurry, speaking tenderly, affirming that God still sees and remembers. Comfort then takes form in action: food for the hungry, shelter for the displaced, protection for the vulnerable.

You, our partners, are helping accomplish all this—feeding, protecting, and restoring lives in Yeshua's name. God is the healer of the brokenhearted, and together, we are His hands of comfort to a wounded land.

"Where Was God?"

On one of our recent tours, a young Israeli asked a question that stilled us all: "Where was God on October 7?" It wasn't curiosity — it was the cry of a wounded heart.

One by one, young people from our group responded—not with arguments, but with compassion. They spoke of God's faithfulness, His presence in dark times, and the hope they had found in Yeshua. No one rushed; silence gave space for truth to sink in.

Slowly, the young Israeli's expression softened. Then, with a quiet smile, they said, "I see your light... and I want that for my life." Hope broke through and a life was changed forever.



Seeing Gaza - and Israel - Through God's Eyes

Headlines can either hijack theology or drive us deeper into God's Word. God's covenant with Israel still stands (Gen. 12:3; Rom. 11:1–2). Supporting Israel is not a political endorsement, but an alignment with His redemptive plan. True shalom doesn't come from treaties between nations—it comes from the Prince of Peace, Yeshua, Jesus, the One who will return to reign from Jerusalem. The war in Gaza is a spiritual battle (Eph. 6:12). Hamas enslaves its own people while seeking Israel's destruction.

As watchmen (Isa. 62:6–7), we are called to pray for Jerusalem's peace (Ps. 122:6), to comfort God's people, and to hold fast, with clarity and compassion, seeing both Israel and Gaza through Scripture, God's heart, and Messiah's promised return.
