## A LITTLE HOPE FROM A SMALL DREIDEL



**Nes Gadol Haya Sham**  
*A Great Miracle Happened There.*

Every Hanukkah, children across the Jewish world spin a small four-sided dreidel, marked with four Hebrew letters: **Nun (נ)**, **Gimel (ג)**, **Hey (ה)**, **Shin (ש)**. Together they form the acronym “**Nes Gadol Haya Sham**” – *A great miracle happened there*. It’s a simple toy, yet this little spinning top carries a message that God often begins His greatest miracles in the smallest places, with the smallest signs of hope.

The Maccabees faced impossible odds, and yet one tiny jar of oil – just enough for one night – became the spark of eight days of supernatural light. God met His people, not after the battle was over, but **right in the middle of the darkness**.

This year, as entire Israeli communities are waking each morning wondering how to rebuild – how to take the next step, Hanukkah is a reminder that **night is never the final word** and the four letters of the dreidel reminds us that even the smallest hope can carry God’s greatest light.

Through your partnership, both Jews and Christians are working together to kindle new flames of hope by bringing comfort, healing, and practical help to those standing in the rubble of a painful year.
